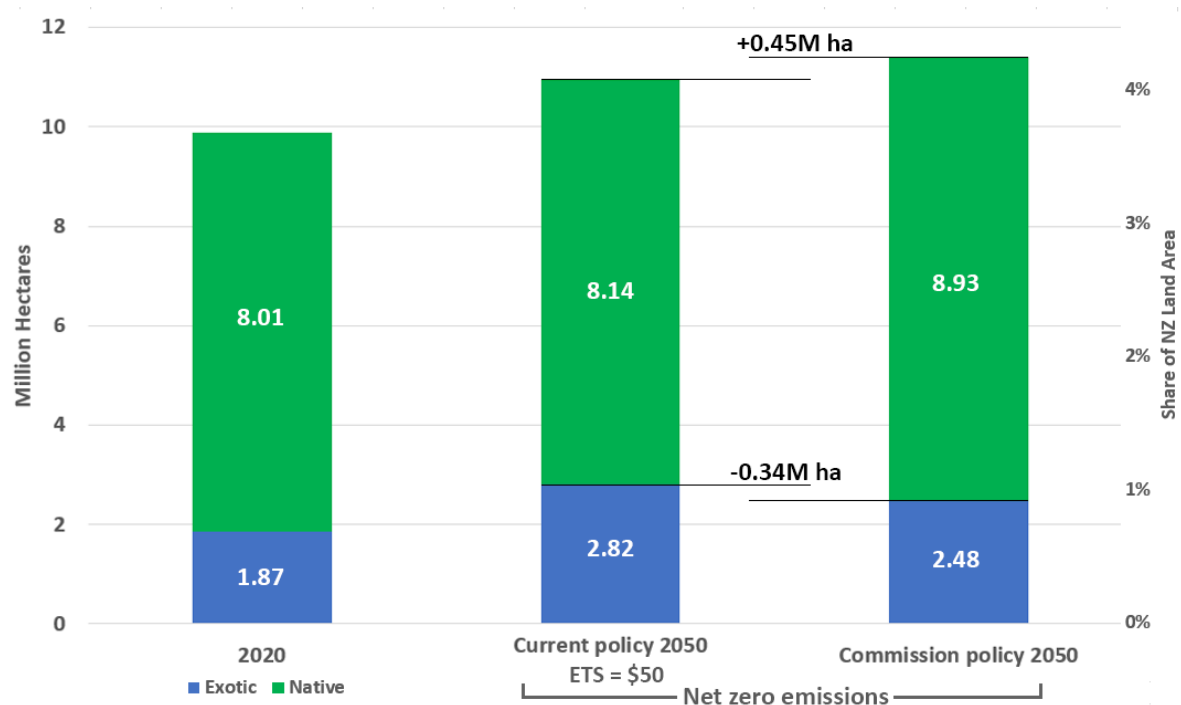


No need for transformation: According to the CCC, current policy settings deliver net zero emissions with marginally more exotic trees and marginally fewer trees overall.



Nothing to fear from current emissions policies. The Climate Change Commission's analysis shows current policies including the ETS can get us to our 2050 emissions targets. Crucially, the Commission shows current policies do not lead to excessive forestry. In fact, the Commission's plan plants more trees overall than current policies, and only slightly less exotic trees.

The Commission's analysis shows about three-quarters of the reduction in net emissions is by decarbonisation, not trees, by 2075 with current policies. NZ is on track to net zero emissions.
